Family Transition Place's Rural Response Program provides support to women in the rural communities of North Dufferin. The Rural Response Community Engagement Facilitator will be engaged in: creating awareness, providing information through workshops and presentations, seeking out and building community relationships, as well as conducting surveys/focus groups.

Responsibilities will include:

- Conducting community surveys (online/in person) and/or focus groups to understand attitudes toward Gender Based Violence (GBV) services and GBV service options
- Seeking out and developing partnerships with underserved populations in the North Dufferin area
- Providing community development and awareness initiatives; including targeted workshops and outreach call with community partners
- Participating in and assisting with the planning and organization of services
- Maintaining electronic data records (i.e. service events, referral sources) according to agency and funders' requirement

Qualifications and Core Competencies:

- Completed post-secondary education in the community development discipline or training and experience in a closely related field
- Knowledge of violence against women and children issues
- Strong public speaking and presentation skills
- Strong networking abilities to build community relationships and partnerships
- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal
- Ability to demonstrate the following: professional attitude & boundaries, self-starter, flexibility, strong decision making skills, follow through, and attention to detail
- Ability to work well independently and in a team
- Demonstrated ability to work with a variety of people, situations and challenges
- Ability to work within the agency's core values of: Compassion, Integrity, Respect, Inclusiveness, Continuous Learning and Innovation

Hours of Work:

- 35 hours per week. Some evening and week-end work may be required.
