Shelter Relief Counsellors are an important component of Family Transition Place's services and programs.

Relief Counsellors are responsible for providing:

- Crisis Line response and support
- Supportive one-on-one and group counselling;
- Information and referral to appropriate legal, medical and housing services and other community resources
- Completion of administrative tasks i.e. record keeping, intake procedures, reports
- Routine facility maintenance and security procedures

Qualifications:

- Post-Secondary Education in the Social Services field
- Understanding of violence against women and children issues
- Crisis intervention and problem solving skills
- Strong supportive counselling skills
- Good written and oral communication skills
- Knowledge of community resources and how to access them
- Basic knowledge of facility management
- Ability to work both cooperatively as a team member and independently with minimal supervision
- Skill in the use of a personal computer for word processing
- Vulnerable Sector Records Check
- Reliable transportation

- As-Needed basis within a rotating schedule of day, evening, overnight & weekend shifts.
